1. Live in Conclave; \$650

3 days of morning and afternoon workshops, 2 nights accommodation and all meals. Let us know of your choices from the activities list when you confirm your booking. Starts 9 am Sat 19th April concludes 4pm Monday 21st April.

2. Guided Fishing Days; \$300 each twin share or \$600 single

A variety of guided fly fishing options offered each day. Organise a friend to share or it is likely that we can match you with someone.

3. Day attendance of activities; \$100/day

Day attendance of activities is welcomed from local fly fishers. Lunch, morning and afternoon tea is provided with the tuition.

4. Stay On Program; \$105/night

We are pleased to give you the opportunity to 'Stay On' after the conclave and enjoy our fly fishing facility and the fishing that northern Tasmania is famous for. Cost includes accommodation, dinner, bed and breakfast and use of our boat on Brumbys.

5. Hayes on Brumbys – Carbon Credit Program; \$10

Please note that Launceston is the most convenient airport to fly in and out of.

If you require a vehicle then please consider hiring from our fly fishing friend Brendon Ayers who owns Europcar in Tasmania. Brendon can be contacted on 0419 569 541.

Alternatively a taxi can be arranged to transfer you by contacting Gary from Town and Country Taxi Service on 0438 133 020. Airport return fare is about \$120

For East Coast Bream and Highland guiding services you are required to arrange your own transport to St Helens and Arthurs Lake respectively.

All you are required to bring to the conclave is your personal effects, suitable clothing, wet weather gear and your casting and fishing equipment.
